RVC resident earns engineering honors

John Cameron, founder and managing partner of Woodbury-based Cameron Engineering & Associates, LLP recently earned two accolades as part of Long Island Business News's 2018 Architecture and Engineering Awards.

The publication named Cameron as this year's top engineer, and his firm earned top engineering firm honors. Cameron, a Rockville Centre resident who has received many honors throughout his career, including Kings Pointer of the Year- his Alma Mater's highest award - New York state's Consulting Engineer of the Year and CEO of the Year by Long Island Business News. He was also named a New York Water Environment Association's Hall of Fame inductee.

Cameron Engineering, which has received more than 50 engineering awards in the past 20

years, has also just received high honors for a number of their projects, including Diamond Awards -the American Council of Engineering Companies of New York's highest engineering awards -for two of its projects. One was for an innovative water reclamation design on one of the firm's New York City Fire- house Design projects on Staten Island, and another was for the Clean & Green Biosolids Project, in which the residuals from wastewater treatment plants are thermally dried and stabilized, which qualifies the product for unrestricted use.
